






INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR ROUND BALE PERFORMER HAY TARPS

**THOUGH THIS OPERATION CAN BE PERFORMED ALONE,
IT IS RECOMMENDED TO HAVE AT LEAST ONE ADDITIONAL PERSON FOR INSTALLATION**



- ① TIE A KNOT IN THE CENTER OF EACH ROPE AS A GUIDE TO SET THE CENTER ROUND BALE ON.
- ② LAY OUT THE ROPES ON THE GROUND STARTING THE FIRST ONE 8" BACK FROM THE END OF THE STACK (TO ATTACH THE END DRAW STRINGS TO). THE SECOND ROPE SHOULD BE APPROXIMATELY 20" FROM THE END OF THE STACK AND AT 55" INTERVALS THEREAFTER. AT THE END OF THE TARP ADD ANOTHER EXTRA ROPE TO TIE THE END DRAW STRINGS TO. (FIG 1)
- ③ THE HAY TARP HAS A CENTER TAB PROTRUDING OUT. THE TARP SHOULD BE INSTALLED WITH THE WHITE SIDE UP. POSITION THE TAB AT THE CENTER OF THE TOP END BALE (FIG. 2)
- ④ INSERT THE LONG ROPE THROUGH THE BACK OF THE SUPER CINCH AND PULL DOWN AS HARD AS YOU CAN TO TIGHTEN. FIRST BOTH ENDS OF THE TARP, THEN THE MIDDLE AND THEN THE REST. GO BACK AROUND THE STACK PULLING SIDWAYS ON THE ROPES TO PULL OUT ANY SLACK IN THE ROPE FROM UNDER THE BALES AND RETIGHTEN THEM. IF YOU'RE SUPER CINCH NEEDS TO BE TIGHTENED (ONLY TIGHTEN 12" MAX). A PROPERLY TIGHTENED TARP WILL HAVE ROPES THAT "TWANG" LIKE A GUITAR STRING. 150LBS. OR MORE OF TIE-DOWN PRESSURE IS RECOMMENDED.
- ⑤ CHECK AND RETIGHTEN YOUR TARP AS NEEDED.
- ⑥ USING MULTIPLE TARPS ON LONG STACKS IS RECOMMENDED. THIS MAKES INSTALLATION EASIER AND ALLOWS PART OF THE STACK TO BE UNCOVERED FOR HAY REMOVAL. WHEN REMOVING TARPS ROLL THEM UP PROPERLY AND STORE AWAY FROM RODENTS.
- ⑦ WHEN REMOVING A FEW BALES OF HAY, FOLD THE TARP BACK ON TO THE FULLY TARPED HAY AND RETIGHTEN.




Protecting Your Investment

Performer™ Hay Tarp

Step 1: Stretch your tarp out on the ground with the black side up first and allow tarp to dry. Take broom and remove any debris. Inspect tarp for any holes and repair with ITL HD repair tape. Once tarp is dry turn the tarp over and let the white side dry off. Clean off any debris. (Hint: For holes 1" to 2" in diameter and small tears place repair tape on both sides of tarp for maximum strength.)

Step 2: Once tarp is dry and repairs have been made you can begin fan folding your tarp. (Hint: Fan folding works best with 2 people.) You can leave the super cinches tied to the tarp during storage. This way your tarp will be ready to install the next time and prevent misplacing the super cinches. Fan fold your tarp with the white side up. Starting on one end of the tarp, place your foot on the edge of the tarp 2'-3' from the end. Then reach down and grasp the tarp and pull it toward you folding it over your foot.

Step 3: Now that the tarp is completely fan folded tuck in the 4 webbing straps from each corner and roll both ends toward the center and tie bundle together with a piece of rope.

Hint: If you wish you can store the bundle of long ropes that laid on the ground to secure the tarp by laying them in the middle between the 2 rolled ends.

Storage: Store tarp inside building off the ground to help prevent any rodent damage.

Hint: Place hand full of moth balls in both ends of tarp bundle to help keep mice out.
